Summary of Academic and Administrative Audit 2017-18 to 2019-20

Observations:

1. The institution follows the curriculum developed by affiliating University SPPU.
2. The College prepares Academic Calendar at the beginning of the academic year and it is followed as per schedule.
3. The institution has the Annual as well as Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and academic flexibility for UG and PG students with the choice of elective courses.
4. Feedback on curriculum has been conducted periodically from students, teachers, employer, alumni.
5. The social awareness is achieved through NSS activities and the gender equity issues are addressed through Gender Sensitivity Programme. The environment awareness rallies and environment related programmes are regularly organized in the college.
6. Enrolment of students is done on merit and as per Government norms.
7. Slow learners are identified at entry level by conducting tests.
8. Special guidance and motivation is provided to advanced learners to prepare them to participate in various competitions.
9. The college has 02 ICT enabled classrooms, 10 laboratories with necessary facilities and internet access.
10. At present college has 05 teachers with Ph.D., 05 M.Phil. and 15 teachers with NET/SET.
11. Teachers are aware of POs, PSOs, and COs and are communicated to the stakeholders.
12. The college regularly conducts internal tests and term end examination of UG and PG students. Under the choice based credit system continuous assessment is undertaken for UG and PG courses as per the guidelines given by affiliating University.
13. Results of all departments are satisfactory.
14. Feedback on teachers' assessment by students is conducted by college every year and analysis report is communicated to concerned teachers for corrective measures.
15. Social activities such as Health Check-up Camps, Blood Donation Camps, Road Shows for Social awareness, tree plantation are regularly conducted by college through NSS students.
16. The college has adequate infrastructure facilities as per University norms.
17. The central library has 6670 books and reference books. In addition, Library management System is automated with OPAC.

18. There are 83 computers with internet bandwidth of 20 Mbps and printers.
19. 62 percentage of students have received scholarships from different governing and non-governing bodies.
20. Well-developed indoor and outdoor sport facilities for students are available.
21. The vision and mission of the institution is well defined and in tune with the objectives of higher education.
22. Birth Anniversaries of Scientists, Leaders, National and International Days are celebrated. BSW, Bahishhal and Soft Skill development programmes are conducted to inculcate values among students.
23. The college has functional IQAC, College Development Committee, Research Committee, Grievance Redressal Cell, Anti Ragging Committee, Library etc. for smooth conduct of academic and administrative work.
24. Different welfare schemes like 'Group Insurance', Gratuity, 'Loan facilities through credit societies' etc. are provided to the staff.
25. The College has mentor mentee scheme under which student meetings are conducted regularly and counselling of student's is done.
26. There is well-developed mechanism for mobilization of resources.
27. Best practices identified are Expert Talk series, Departmental Events, industrial Visits and Training programmes for Final Year students for Personality Development.
28. The college has Training and Placement cell provides Guidance to UG and PG students.
29. The college has safe and secure environment and the campus is under CCTV surveillance.
30. Various Induction Programmes, Parent's meet, Alumni meet, Convocation programmes are conducted by the college.

2. To design need based skill programmes for better placement
3. To encourage entrepreneurship development with the help of Alumni
4. Effective participation in Government Aided Schemes
5. To develop industrial linkages for improving training and placements

2. To attract high ranking students for admissions
3. To avail funds from external funding agencies for academics and infrastructural development of college.

Recommendations/Comments

1. Initiate the process for UGC recognition under 2(f) and 12(b). Also apply for Permanent affiliation from University.
2. To appoint approved principal
3. Get University approval for more number of teaching staff.
4. Departmental library shall be setup in UG and PG departments.
5. PG courses can be started for Economics department.
6. The activities under MoUs can be increased.
7. Separate Maintenance committee should be appointed for maintenance of infrastructural facilities.
8. To motivate teachers for participation in conference, seminars, workshops and research publication.
9. Facilities for Divyangjan students should be increased.
10. To promote use of ICT in teaching, learning and evaluation.
11. To start journals and Periodicals in library.

12. Well-furnished seminar hall, gymkhana, and canteen should be developed.
13. Get approval for the curriculum of existing add-on and certificate courses from the University.
