Late Shri. Balasaheb Deoram Wagh

Balasaheb Wagh alias Bhau a symbol of DETERMINATION – DEVOTION-DILIGENCE

The late Shri. Balasaheb Wagh, alias Bhau (1932-2022), was a visionary, a great humanitarian and a quintessential reformer who has left behind an impeccable paradigm of selflessness and dedication. He devoted his life to uplift

rural masses and made remarkable contributions in various fields including agriculture, social work, the cooperative sector, education, fine arts, sports, forestation and water conservation, to name a few.

He was born into the legendary family of Padma Shri Awardee Karmaveer Kakasaheb Wagh and Smt. Geetai Wagh. His personality blossomed in the influential company of his able father's reputable and progressive friends, associates and well-wishers, notably Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil, Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh, Karmaveer Bhausaheb Hire, Padma Bhushan Awardee Vasantdada Patil, Karmaveer Dadasaheb Gaikwad, Krantisinh Nana Patil, Gyanpeeth Awardee Kavi Kusumagraj and grandfather Sayaji Wagh.

Shri. Balasaheb Wagh completed his graduation in agriculture from Government College of Agriculture, Pune and joined as an agricultural officer in Maharashtra Sugar Factory, Tilak Nagar, Shrirampur, in the early 1960s. He served as a secretary at Sanjeevani Co-operative Sugar factory, Kopargaon. With his able management and people skills, Shri. Balasaheb Wagh soon climbed the ranks, becoming Managing Director at Niphad Co-operative Sugar Factory (Dist. Nashik, Maharashtra) and Chairman at K K Wagh Co-operative Sugar Factory, Ranwad (Dist. Nashik, Maharashtra).

He was associated with and worked for the betterment of various oraganizations, notably Nashik District Central Co-operative Bank, Deccan Sugar Technologists Association Pune, Deccan Sugar Institute (now called Vasantdada Sugar Institute (VSI) Pune, National Heavy Engineering Corporation Ltd. and Distillery Association of Maharashtra. He was instrumental in the establishment of the Niphad Taluka Grahak Mandal, Kakasahebnagar Grahak Sahakari Sanstha, Kakasahebnagar, Fruits and Vegetables Association, and Medical Trust at his village. He was elected as Director for Nashik District Central Co-operative Bank (NDCC) for the period 1980-1985.

Shri. Balasaheb Wagh pioneered the construction of 250+ irrigation weirs/bunds (Karmaveer Bandhare) in Niphad Taluka of Nashik District as a cooperative initiative during his tenure as President of Karmaveer Kakasaheb Wagh Sahakari Sakhar Karkhana Ltd. This has proved to be a boon to Socio-Eco upliftment of farmers in the region and provided a new model for water management for irrigated agriculture.

Considering his in-depth knowledge in the field of water resources, irrigation and the cooperative movement, the Government of Maharashtra and then Chief Minister included him in the Second Irrigation Commission of Maharashtra as a member in 1995. This commission was constituted

under the chairmanship of Dr. Madhavrao Chitale, a world-renowned figure in the Water Sector and Stockholm Awardee. This commission submitted a detailed report which became the basis for long-term water management planning of the state.

Being an environmentalist, utilizing his deep expertise and micro-level knowledge in geography and agriculture, he preserved more than a hundred varieties of the rarest tree species. Taking a step towards a safer environment, he initiated the idea of 'Eco-friendly Ganesha' almost a decade ago. This initiative has encouraged millions of other people to shift to eco-friendly practices and has significantly reduced the pollution of water bodies.

Owning a deep sense of inclination for the arts, he established the 'Kala Academy,' where he promoted Indian classical music among the youth and encouraged other art forms by inviting experts from all around the nation. Numerous experimental workshops for singing, drawing, painting, and sculpture were conducted, fostering creativity and artistic expression.

Inspired by the teachings and guidance of the late Padma Shri Awardee Karmaveer Kakasaheb Wagh, Shri. Balasaheb Wagh dedicated himself to establishing and elevating educational institutions to new heights of reputation and integrity. While serving as a Trustee, Vice-President, and President of K K Wagh Education Society since 1970, he played a pivotal role in the establishment of schools (CBSE & State Board) and colleges spanning diverse fields, including Engineering, Pharmacy, Agriculture, Fine Art, Performing Art, as well as traditional Arts, Science, Commerce, and Computer Science. He significantly contributed to the accreditation of Engineering Colleges and Polytechnics, consistently striving to enhance both quality and quantity by attracting proficient faculty and introducing new branches and disciplines. Shri. Balasaheb Wagh was a radical pioneer who walked the extra mile to ensure girls get into mainstream development. Being an alchemist in his approach, he strived for spreading the mark of K K Wagh across the globe with world class education system. His continuous efforts resulted in the establishment of nine campuses and thirty different institutes by 2022. Due to his rich experience in agriculture and love for nature, all campuses of K K Wagh Education Society metamorphosed into lush greenery in the form of rare varieties of floral biodiversity.

Shri. Balasaheb Wagh played a prime role in the establishment of the Association of Managements of Unaided Engineering, Polytechnics and Agriculture & Agriculture Allied Colleges in Maharashtra. Due to his work and commitment, he was elected unopposed as President of these three state-level Associations for 16 to 17 years. Through this, he brought around 700 unaided Professional institutes in the State of Maharashtra under the umbrella of these associations and worked relentlessly to solve their problems.

On the occasion of his 80th Birthday, then Chief Minister of Maharashtra felicitated and acclaimed Shri. Balasaheb Wagh as the 'Sage' and conferred upon him the title of the 'Torch-Bearer' for illuminating the lives of several thousand people through education. He received numerous prestigious awards including Krushi Jeevan Gaurav Puraskar, Jeevan Sadhana Gaurav Puraskar, Edupreneurs Award, Nashik Bhushan Puraskar, Samajratna, and Pitru Puraskar, in recognition of his valuable contributions to the social, agricultural and educational fields.

A prominent name in the fraternity who strived for the betterment of people, Shri. Balasaheb Wagh was a true Gandhian. He was very soft-spoken and wore the crown of simplicity, ensured that he wears and eats only local, believing in the concept of a self-sufficient village. A man of very simple living and high thinking, dedicated his life towards improving basics and worked tirelessly for 65 years to bring a difference in the lives of rural people. An ordinary man with an extraordinary zeal to serve society has reformed a million lives and engraved a permanent place in the hearts of every single soul he touched! A beacon of inspiration, he lived a vibrant and active life for 89 years, leaving behind a legacy that will be cherished and remembered for generations to come.

Earlier he was

active in the development of Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj, which has been established as a center of learning for over 100 years. He was also instrumental in setting up three cooperative sugar factories in Nashik district. As a leader of farmers, he represented Niphad Tehsil in the State Legislative Assembly.

K K Wagh Education Society later on received a land of 23 acres from the well-known Philanthropist, Late Ratansey Haridas Udeshi (Kakuseth) of Hirabai Hansaraj Surji Charitable Trust and was utilized by K K Wagh Education Society to establish an ideal Technical Campus. This campus is named as 'Hirabai Haridas Vidyanagari' in the name of his mother "Hirabai Haridas". The picturesque campus houses the Engineering College, Polytechnic, Pharmacy, Sports ground, Gymnasium, Canteen, Guest Houses, Society Office, Hostels etc. Kakuseth has established many Schools, Colleges, Dispensaries, Dharam Shalas, Sanatoriums and Temples in many Parts of India."

Later on other educational institutes in the field of Agriculture, Education, Fine Arts, Performing Arts were started in the campus at Sararaswatinagar, Nashik. English Medium Schools, Jr. College and CBSE Schools are also run by the trust in Nashik City & Niphad Tehsil.

With the vision of empowering the youth through quality education, K K Wagh Education Society started colleges with faculties like Arts, Science, Commerce, Computer Science etc. at Nashik, Pimplas (Ramache), Kakasahebnagar and Chandori. These colleges are useful for the children of farmers who were deprived of higher education due to non availability of colleges in their native place. In Chandori village Pharmacy Institute is established for rural students.

The objective of K K Wagh Education Society is to provide quality education at affordable cost. The quality culture has been developed in all the institutes. All institutes have State-of-the-Art laboratories with latest equipments, computers & internet connectivity. All students admitted to the first class will have to fill up a university eligibility form.

Students from other universities should complete the following.

- 1. Application and fee in specific format for University Eligibility Certificate
- 2. University Migration Certificate 3. Passing certificate,
- 4. Original mark sheet

5. Certificate of conduct

All students will get provisional admission. And the admission will be confirm only after getting the eligibility certificate from Savitribai Phule Pune University.

Medical checkup is compulsory for all the students admitted in the first year on the date fixed by the college. Otherwise the examination form cannot be filled.

The amount required for the journals and files of the practical subjects will have to be paid in addition to the admission fee.

Tuition fees will be charged as per the rules of Savitribai Phule Pune University.

Students will have to pay all fees at the time of admission.

Refund of fees

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the college / institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the students.

Sr.	Percentage of refund of fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the institute
1.	100%	15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission
2.	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission
3.	80%	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission
4.	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days after formally notified last date of admission
5.	00%	More than 30 days after formally notified last date of admission

Note:

- 1. In case of Sr. No. (1) in the table above, the college / institution concerned shall deduct all amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5000 / as processing charges from the refundable amount.
- 2. Fees shall be refund by all college / institution to an eligible student within 15 days from the date of receiving a written application from him / her in this regards.

Under the University Act, Maharashtra Public University Act 2016 and all the rules made by the Board of Trustees of the educational institution, the students should strictly follow the rules in the college premises, in the classroom, in the library, in the program, during the examination.

- Every student must carry his / her identity card with him / her otherwise his / her admission to the college premises may be denied and he / she may be subject to legal action.
- 2. Every student should treat college principal, department head, professor, non-Teaching staff and fellow students with tolerance and humility.
- 3. Students must attend the practical. If you don't have lecture, you should study in the library. Missing lectures and going out can be annoying to others. As a result, the academic environment of the college becomes polluted and it becomes a noticeable crime.
- All students admitted in the first year will have to attend the compulsory medical checkup of the university. Absentees will not be able to fill up the university examination form.
- 5. It is strictly forbidden to smoke, consume intoxicants, eat spices or spit in the premises of the college.
- 6. It is strictly forbidden to take photos in the college premises without the prior permission of the principal.
- 7. It is strictly forbidden to carry any weapon that may cause injury to others in the college premises.
- 8. Park your vehicle in the parking lot.
- Writing on a classroom wall, bench, board, toilet wall or throwing rubbish elsewhere is a sign of a perverted attitude. Care should be taken not to display it.
- 10. Shouting inside or outside the classroom, making noise on the stairs, talking loudly in the library should not be done as it is annoying to others.
- 11. The trees and flowers in the college yard, the classroom furniture, the lamps, the fans, the window glass, and the laboratory equipment are the property of the college and alternatively our own. It is your duty to use it carefully without harming it.
- 12. It is not allowed to visit the trip or other institutions without the prior permission of the principal or to collect donations from each other and no event can be organized.
- 13. No media person or seller will be allowed to enter the college.
- 14. Students will not be allowed to participate in any political, social or religious movements. Or such associations may not enter the premises without prior permission or students may not establish such associations.
- With the permission of the principal, students can participate in constructive, educational, cultural and competitive activities.

- Inducing or aiding in copying in an examination is a notifiable offense which can lead to police action or penal action.
- 17. The original copy of the certificate and other documents will not be returned after admission.
- Making changes to the original documents, submitting false documents, tampering with or signing another are offenses.
- 19. If the student does not have 80% attendance in class, he / she will not be able to fill up the examination form.
- 20. According to Maharashtra Government and Savitribai Phule Pune University Ragging Prevention Act, admission of a student related to ragging will be canceled and strict action will be taken against him.
- 21. If the student has any complaints or suggestions, they should be put in the complaint box. Complaint suggestions will be viewed only by the principal and action will be taken accordingly.
- 22. Keep the mobile off mode as long as it is in the college premises. Violation of these rules will result in a minimum penalty of Rs. 50 /-. Complaints of mobile theft, or misuse by another, etc. will not be accepted. It is strictly forbidden to carry a mobile phone during the examination period or in the examination hall.
- 23. The institute has fixed uniforms for college students and it is mandatory to wear them. A sample of the uniform is displayed on the notice board.
- 24. The student should not invite relatives, acquaintances or any other person to visit each other's colleges, if there is any important work, such visit should be made only with the prior permission of the principal. Otherwise, action will be taken against outsiders and students.
- 25. In addition to the above rules, the rules made by the principal as well as the head of the department or as suggested by the K K Wagh Education Society for relevant reasons will be binding on every student.

In case of non-compliance with the above laws and regulations, the following action may be taken against the concerned.

- Revocation of students from college.
- 2. Dismissing specific student sessions.
- 3. Retention of examination form.
- 4. Maintaining test results.
- 5. Immediate access cancellation.
- 6. Expulsion from college or examination.
- 7. To penalize.
- 8. Cancellation of fees or deposits.
- 9. To take police action.


