Department Activities

English:

The department of English has two faculty members: Prof. D.N.Durgest, Prof. S.D.Gaikwad. The student strength of the department is 37.

A certificate course was conducted through the department during 6th December 2017 to 4th February 2018 for the students who are interested in enhancing their communication skills. There were 30 students. For this course Prof. D.N. Durgest, Prof. S. D. Gaikwad worked as the instructors. Initially the students were taught Basic English Grammar. To make learning more interesting and informal, the students were introduced into audio visual learning. It was a good opportunity for students to improve their English and to develop confidence. The students were encouraged to communicate only in English. The course was fruitful.

The average result of the department is 61.45%.

Marathi:

The department of Marathi has two faculty members: HOD Prof. Thoke A.S & Prof. M. A. Gundgal. The student strength of the department is 40. The department was celebrated “Marathi Bhasha Gaurav Din” under the guidance of Principal Dr. S. S. Wagh.

A certificate course was conducted through the department during 12th November 2017 to 30 January 2018 for the students who are interested in enhancing their proof reading. 30 students successfully completed the course. For this course Prof. M. A. Gundgal and Prof. Thoke worked as the instructors. Initially the students were taught Basic Marathi Grammer. It was a good opportunity for students to improve their Marathi and to develop confidence. The students were encouraged to communicate also in Marathi. The certificates were distributed to the concerned students at the end of the course.

Poetry reading Competition and Essay Writing Competition are conducted by the Department of Marathi.

The average result of the department is 72.50%.

Economics:

The Department of Economics was establish in year 2004 – 05. It has three Faculty members. Dr.Santosh S. Wagh, Dr. Savita G. Sawant, Prof. Savita V. Bhandare. The student strength of the department is 55.

A certificate course 'Basic concept of Research Methodology' was conducted through the department during 3rd November 2017 to 5th January 2018. For the students who are interested in enhancing their Knowledge. There were 39 students were participated and successfully completed the certificate course in this year. For this course Dr. S. G. Sawant & Prof. S.V. Bhandare worked as the instructors.

The average result of the department is 61.26%.

Geography:

The department of Geography has two faculty members Prof. M. M. Jadhav and Prof.S. D. Athare .The student strength of the department is 35. On behalf of Department

Geography the Certificate course 'Method of Surveying' was conducted for the academic year 2017-18 from 03/01/2018 to 17/02/2018 for the students. 35 students were participated and successfully completed the certificate course in this year.

The Department of Geography organized Educational Tour at Nandur Madhmeshwar. Nandur Madhmeshwar is one of the most famous and unique natural place of Bird sanctuaries about 5000 – 6000 Birds were present in winter season. In this some of migratory resident most common flamingo, duck, Cranes stork Pintails etc.

The average result of the department is 62.28 %

Commerce:

The Faculty of commerce has been started since 2004 at UG level and 321 students were admitted. In this whole year student's development was centred and various lectures were organized. The department involve 6 faculties with well-educated.

In this year commerce forum was inaugurated and various activity were conducted under this forum; viz Rangoli competition, posted competition and field visit.

In the year 2017-18 the department has started GST (Goods & Services Tax) Certificate course and 30 Student's Participated in this course.

Science:

The Faculty of Science has six faculty members: Prof. Wani S.S., Prof. Jadhav V.R., Prof. Panghavhane A.D., Prof. Borade P.A., Prof. Bhalerao S.B., Prof. Khairnar D.N. The student strength of the Science Faculty is 118.

Faculty of Science conduct certificate course of "Basic Mathematics" during 20th November to 18th December 2017 for this course Prof. Bhalerao S. B. and Prof. Khairnar D. N. worked as the instructors under the guidance of Principal Dr. S.S. Wagh. Total 40 interested students successfully completed this course.

Computer Science:

Computer Science Department was establish in the year 2005. The department has nine teaching faculties with the student strength 133. The faculty members participated in curriculum designing workshops, Conferences.

For the students who are interested in enhancing their IT skills, department of computer Science conducted certificate course of 36 hours entitled "Computer Awareness & Basics of Internet" during 20th November to 20th December 2018. Total 31 students enrolled for this course & Certificates are issued them after successfully completed the course.

Department celebrated various days like Teachers day, Mathematical day, Science day. 10 students are participated in one day workshop on "Avishkar Orientation 2017 jointly

organized by SSSM Arts, Science & Commerce College, Saikheda and SPPU, Pune on 26th September 2017.

The Final year result for under graduate is 78.57% and for post-graduation is 59.25%.

Training & Placement Cell:

Our College has Training and Placement cell. Various activities are conducted throughout the year by the Cell.

On 15th and 16th December 2017 the soft skill and Communication Program was conducted by the Organization Barclay-GTT & NASSCOM Foundation. Mr. Ajay D'Almeida guided about the different opportunities in market which are available for Students. Various questions were asked by the students and have been cleared by the resource person.

The Per-Placement Training Program was organized on 19th and 20th January 2018 by the organization Career Launcher, Nashik. The trainers Mr. Sohil Shah, Mr. Kiran Derle, Mr. Ajinkya Chopde guided the students through the various examples.

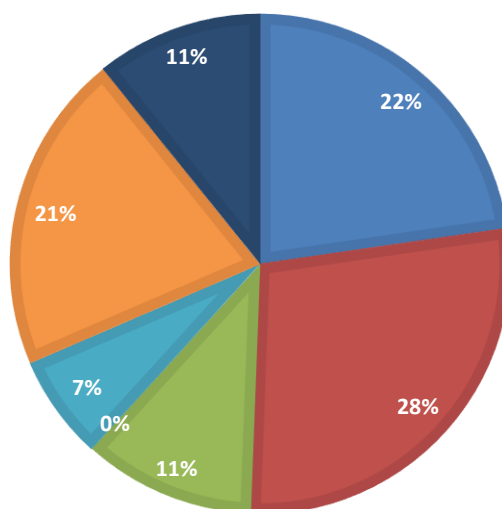
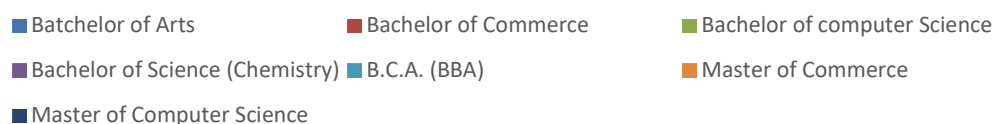
