Activities carried out by the Department

Geography Day

On January 14, 2023, Geography Day was celebrated. On that occasion, an expert lecture of Dr. Savita Sawant was held. She guided the students on the correlation between geography and economics, how geographical factors affect the economic activities and businesses and in this connection the branches of economic geography, transport geography, commercial geography, resource geography have also been developed.

Poster Exhibition

Poster exhibition competition was conducted to increase the geographical knowledge of students on the occasion of Geography Day. The students presented their thoughts on solar system, environment conservation, ozone depletion, save water save water, types of rain, solar eclipse and its types through a poster exhibition.

Model Exhibition

A model exhibition was held on the occasion of Geography Day. In it, the children of the earth. Models were presented on elements such as the Earth's sphere, volcanic eruptions, solar system and atmospheric composition.

Certificate Course

In addition to studies, a certificate course in Geographical Information System (GIS) has been implemented by the department to provide in-depth knowledge of the subject. 30 students took admission in this two month course.

Field visit

Observation is an important component of geography study. A field visit is included in the curriculum as part of the study. On 02/05/2023 students visited Chandori village. There they visited Mahadev Temple, historical Hingnewada, Godavari River, Nadi Ghat, Maruti Mandir Village, Primary Health Center and Bus Stand, Market and got information.

English:

The department of English has three faculty members: Prof. D. N. Durgest, Prof. A. B. Janjale, and Prof. A. D. Pawar. The student strength of the department is 23.

A certificate course was conducted during 1st October to 10th November 2022 through the department for the students, who are interested in enhancing their communication skills. 35 students successfully completed the course. For this course Prof. D.N. Durgest and Prof. A.B. Janjale, Prof. A.D. Pawar worked as the instructors. Initially the students were taught Basic English Grammar. To make learning more interesting and informal, the students were introduced into audio visual learning. It was a good opportunity for students to improve their English and to develop confidence. The students were encouraged to communicate only in English. The certificates were distributed to the concerned students at the end of the course.

The Department of English organized the study tour on 21st April, 2023 at Nashik with an aim to visit the Kalaram Temple, Swaminarayan Temple, Sakal Printing Press, Anjneri Coin Museum, etc. 06 students with 03 teachers participated in it.

Prof. D. N. Durgest published a research paper on India's Educational System from Ancient to Modern: A Study.

Prof. Anita Pawar also authored a book chapter entitled 'Life Skills and National Education Policy' in the book Interdisciplinary Research Pathway of National Education Policy (NEP-2020).

Economics:

In the academic year 2022-23, the Department of Economics organized various activities related to opportunities in economics, international trade to enhance the subject competence of the students.

- With a view to acquire special skills related to business in students in addition to regular studies, a certificate course in business management was implemented by the department from 15th October 2022 to 30th November 2022. 32 students participated in this course and certificates were distributed to them after completion of the courses
- On 27th April 2023 the inauguration of Economics Forum was done by noted economist Dr. Vinayak Govilkar, Nashik.
- On 8th April 2023 Industrial visit of students of Department of Economics was organized to Sahyadri Firms at Mohadi, Nashik.
- On September 15, 2022, students of the Department of Economics enthusiastically participated in the Avishkar Competition organized by Savitribai Phule Pune University.

Commerce:

Department of Commerce was established in 2004-2005. In the academic year 2022-23 various programs were organized.

- An expert lecture on "Government Sector Opportunities for Youth in 2023". Santosh Patil, Manager of Mahindra Education Pvt Ltd. Was the chief guest of the program.
- A certificate course was organized. The Students were trained in computer accounting through "Tally ERP-9".
- A field visit was also organized to "Rajhans Milk Producers and Processing Association, Sangamner".

Science:

The faculty of Science & technology has eleven faculty members & having good qualification. Department has an excellent infrastructure with six well-equipped laboratories. Laboratories has some important instruments likes spectrophotometer, portable leaf area meter, Turbidity meter, digital balance, pH-meter, Conductivity meter etc.

Department provides many opportunities to students for development of overall personality by participating in the various cultural and co-curricular activities held throughout the year. Department organizes expert lectures of eminent personalities for students. Department also arrange the activities like scientific survey, Educational visit etc to enhance learning ability of students.

A certificate course "Industrial Training" was conducted through the Faculty of Science for the students who are interested in enhancing their practical skill in Industrial field. The outcome of certificate course "Industrial Training" is I) To developed basic understanding regarding various analytical instruments in students. II) To introduced them with basic working of various analytical instruments. III) To enhance their skill to handel the instruments. Due to this students to get better opportunity for job in their career.

On occasion 5th September 2022 Teacher day was celebrated for the students of college,Prin. Dr. R. K. Datir was chief guest of the Teacher day and shared view about recent education change.Students of science faculty was actively participated in this programme.

Faculty of Science celebrates various events on occasion of 28th Feb 2023 National Science Day ,Science week 2022-23 was celebrated between 28-2 march 2023. Faculty of science & technology was conducted various events like Expert lectures on "Importance of Scientific view" for this topic Prof. C. U. Naikwade deliver very nice guidance to students about 80 students were attended these expert lecture. Along with this many activities were conducted in Science week-2022-23 like Rangoli competition, Scientific model making, Poster presentation, Animal out of vegetable, Quiz competition Floral competition etc. students were actively participated in these activities & winner of these competitions gave prize.

The birth anniversary of National Mathematician Shrinivas Ramanujan was celebrated as 'National Mathematics Day' on Wednesday 22nd December 2022 by department of Science in K. K. Wagh Arts, Commerce, Science & Computer Science College, Chandori. The Inauguration function was chaired by vice principal Prof. S. G. Sawant & Prof. P. P. Aher. There speeches enlightened the students about the importance of Mathematics in day to day life.

Educational Visits in academic year 2022-23 were arranges for F.Y.B.Sc. & T.Y.B.Sc. at NHRDF Chitegaon & Sahyadri farm, Mohadi students was get idea about analysis techniques & the processing of fruits & vegetables. About 23 students were attending this educational visit.

Computer Science:

The Department of Computer Science was established in the year 2005 with the objective of imparting quality education in the field of Computer Science and Technology. The Department has modern facilities for teaching, learning process. Department offers programs of study at undergraduate and postgraduate level. The department started three year bachelor program of B.Sc.(Cpmputer Science) and two year master program of M.Sc.(Computer Science) affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune.

Department organizes various expert lectures and seminars of eminent personalities from Software Industries in the

field of Computer science and Technology. Department also arrange the extension activities in various capacities for the benefit of student and staff. The teachers associated with the department are well experienced, qualified and contributing immensely to the growth of department.

With rapidly evolving technology and the continuous need for innovation, the Department has produced quality professionals holding important positions in the IT industry in India and abroad.

Bridge Course

Department of Computer Science, conducted three weeks bridge course from the date 22/09/2022 to 10/10/2022 in offline mode. The main objective of the course is all of use to reach the goal of quality education through teaching and learning.

There is correlation between the syllabus taugth in each class. This was broken due to covid-19 lockdowns and learning gap in students is increased. The basic concepts are not clear for many students, so they cannot be taugth topics of higher complexity which are generally based on the syllabus of previous standard. Each department in college planned and conducted bridge course for our students to improve subject knoledge. Each department designed the course with a syllabus under a department coordinator and head of the department monitors the overall conduct of the course. Faculties like computer science, science, commerce and arts offered this course to their students. Students came from different academic background are benefited of this course.


